Generate Camp Quick Details

What?

Have you ever been in a place that's really and truly dark? A place with absolutely zero sources of light? It's a little unsettling, isn't it? We lose context, we become disoriented. And if we're honest, sometimes we get scared. There's another kind of darkness that surrounds us. It's not the absence of light, it's the absence of good. When?

- Depart Monday, June 14, at 7:00 am (be at Bay Area **NO LATER** than 6:30 am)
- Return Friday, June 18, between 4:00 and 5:00 pm

- Bay Area Christian School bus

How much does it cost?

- \$350.00, if registered on or before May 16. \$375.00 after that date. This can be paid in full at the time of registration or you may pay any amount at any time as long as the following milestones are met:
 - \$100.00 at registration
 - \$125.00 due by May 1, 2021
 - \$125.00 due by June 1, 2021
- This covers all meals, housing, transportation, and camp fees.

How do I sign up?

- **Requires** at least a \$100.00 deposit upon sign up
- This trip is available to all students who are currently in or recently completed 6th-12th grades.

What action steps do I need to take from here in order to secure my spot?

- Register online (registration opens Monday, March 29, 2021)
- Pay deposit or full amount
- Fill out and return Generate Camp Participant form – this form **MUST** be notarized
- Fill out and return Bay Area medical release form, if not already on file for 2021

There are a LIMITED number of spaces for camp this year.
Spots are reserved only when ALL action steps are fulfilled.

Packing List

What to bring

StaySafe

We know when you attend GENERATE each summer you expect and deserve an excellent camp experience. Our team at YM360 has continued to strive to meet these expectations while prioritizing the safety of your students, adults and our staff. We have continued to monitor the impact of COVID-19 and related safety protocols. We know this is also a priority for you as a parent. We have included further focus points here to share more regarding the GENERATE StaySafe plan as we prepare for Summer 2021. While we know that summer is still months away, the following areas are being addressed with more updates coming as we get closer to camp. It should also be noted, that with locations in various states throughout the country there will be a baseline of safety protocols at GENERATE this summer and potentially some expanded focuses in certain areas in line with local health guidelines.

Guidelines will include, but are not limited to:

- Pre-Attendance education for campers, leaders and staff.
- Expanded training focus with staff, including preventative best practices related to health and safety, clear protocols related to guests with symptoms or exposure.
- Expanded pre-camp and day 1 screening for campers including health checklist, temp checks and guardian sign off. Basic daily check list and temp checks for all guests while at GENERATE.
- Isolation protocols.
- Reduced capacity and scheduled mealtimes by color codes (where needed). We will be working with locations on meal distribution and traffic flow that is conducive to each campus and crowd.
- Lodging adjustments as needed, including isolation rooms (varies by campus).
- Main worship gathering seating and capacity adjustments as needed (including a two-service schedule when/if needed).
- Daily health screenings with staff, including temp and symptoms checks twice a day and isolation protocols if symptoms are present.
- Expanded "sanitation stations" for guests including hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes, extra face masks.
- Hygiene and safety reminders during the experience through signage prompts around campus, on main screens and from stage.
- Scheduled daily cleaning in common spaces, on door handles, and other high touch points.
- Mask or face covering guidelines (where/when required).

While it will take some adjustments from how we all normally experience summer camp, we believe the core of the experience and opportunity for God to move in a real way in the lives of your students will be as present as ever. We will include additional GENERATE StaySafe updates as we prepare for your week of camp.

CONNECT Participants: Recreation is offered to build community amongst your group in a fun but in an environment with safety as a priority. It will include physical and challenging activities that may include running, lifting, climbing, descending, carrying, moving, jumping or working with other people during physical activity. Activities may create elevated heart and respiratory rates and require physical exertion. Additionally, unforeseen weather or forces of nature could be encountered during recreation activities.

SERVE Participants: Missions activities including, but not limited to running, playing, moving items, conducting activities, stocking, painting, building light construction projects, removing debris, rubbish or other items may have inherently dangerous elements that involved risks, including but not limited to carrying heavy supplies, using hand tools, climbing ladders, using paints, nailing and serving in various conditions in often high summer temperatures. All participants will be transported to and from worksites under the care and supervision of the church group and leader they came with. It is the responsibility of participants to only participate in activities that they are qualified for and are able to perform safe practices at their specific worksite. Work will be done under the supervision the group leader at each site. All work is done voluntarily and participant assumes any and all risk associated with such activities.

Photography/Video Acknowledgment: Throughout the event there may be photographs and video taken for marketing and promotional purposes. I acknowledge that and grant permission for such media to be used in promotional materials.

Release and Indemnity: I acknowledge and agree that I or my agents hold harmless, release forever, and agree not to sue youthministry360, it's leadership, agents, venues, locations, community partners, volunteers, sponsors from any and all claims or demands related to personal injury, sickness, and even death, as well as any property damage or related expenses, incurred by my participation or my minor child during Generate by YM360.
